# Achievements to date and the positioning of IPLCs in the Post-2020 Biodiversity Framework

During this side-event, indigenous peoples and local community organizations and Parties will based on achievements to date, share views on the positioning on indigenous peoples and local communities in the Post 2020 Biodiversity Framework and possible future work.

Since the WG 8(j) and its programme of work was launched at CBD COP 5 in Nairobi 2000 it has continuously contributed recommendations on how IPLCs knowledge, innovations and practices can be safeguarded and promoted for achieving the goals of the Convention. Indeed, Aichi Target 18 sets out that by the year 2020 traditional knowledge should be fully integrated and reflected in the implementation of the Convention with the full and effective participation of indigenous and local communities, at all relevant levels.

The WG8(j) has over time become an important fora to share experiences and ideas related to knowledge, innovations and practices of indigenous peoples and local communities. It has developed methods and practises for full and effective participation by IPLCs, and has served as model and inspiration also for other international negotiations.

The SBI 2 will discuss the integration of Article 8 (j) and provisions related to indigenous peoples and local communities in the work of the Convention and its Protocols, and this side event is intended as a fora for in-depth reflections related to this issue.
